To recommend commendations for performance that exemplifies best practices recognizing excellence, quality, efficiency, significance and effectiveness; to review current mechanisms for evaluation, or recommend new methods to assess, effectiveness of CCE staff and of individual board members, and the board as a whole, to encourage and recommend practices/policies that will lead to greater levels of effective CCE communication, both internally (within CCE) and externally; and, to evaluate CCE's compliance with best accreditation practices, such as those established by CHEA, ASPA, and other relevant organizations, and make recommendations for improvement. To review current mechanisms for evaluation, or recommend new methods to assess, effectiveness of the staff, board, COA and Site Team Academy as organizational units of CCE.
