January 10-11, 2025

Summary of Major Actions and Discussion
(These are not official minutes of the CCE Council.)

Chair Dr. Kristina Petrocco-Napuli called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Public Comment Session

During the meeting the Council received oral comments from Dr. Michael Guinosso and Dr. Scott Kelly.

CCE President's Update

The CCE President updated the Council on milestone achievements over the last year including the provision of two separate Appeals Panel; the CCE Standards Symposium training for Councilors, Site Team Academy Members, and Representatives from doctor of chiropractic programs; and, for supporting research in chiropractic education.

Committee Reports

The Council received updates from the Communications Committee, the Site Team Academy Committee, the Audit Committee, the Council Development Committee, the Council Executive Committee, and the Competency Based Education Task Force.

Proposed Policy Revisions

The Council approved revisions in CCE Policy 1, to include provisions for Competency-Based Education; CCE Policy 7, by deleting the policy based on revisions to the CCE Standards; CCE Policy 8, to revise fee requirements; and, CCE Policy 56, by adding residency program completion and employment rate requirements.

Financial Reports

The Council received the FY24-25 second quarter balance sheet and financial reports and FY24 investment reports.
